Would you like to improve your Spanish, take a cultural holiday in Malaga and share the experience with other mature students?

Several times a year, we offer you the chance to practise and improve your Spanish with other adult students. The programme also enables you to explore the city with a Spanish guide and sample the culture, enjoy a traditional meal and tour some of the amazing sights that Malaga offers.

Course Format:

Two or four weeks duration 15 group language lessons per week (mixed age group) plus social programme per week Max. 10 people per class Levels: All ability levels

Timetable:

Morning timetable plus Over 50 social programme in the afternoons and some evenings





Course Notes

A short Spanish language course aimed at older students who wish to study, in a more relaxed environment, with their peer group. Structured Spanish lessons are complimented by an activity programme.

Aimed at those older students who wish to study with their peers whilst concentrating on developing their communication skills and enjoying a varied social activity programme.

Courses are aimed at three abilities; beginner, intermediate and advanced levels.

Beginners concentrate on highly practical situations whilst more advanced students will discuss aspects of Spanish life, society, culture and politics.

Activities may include shopping in the central market, a cookery or Sevillanas dance class, lunch with a teacher, a visit to the Alcazaba (castle) and the Cathedral or a trip to the botanical gardens. There will also be a full day Saturday excursion i.e. to Granada.

Accommodation

Students can choose to stay with local Spanish hosts (great for practising your Spanish out of class!) or in the on site residence (very nice room standard offered!).

Spanish hosts:

You will be provided with a single room with hosts or a hostess, on a half-board basis (breakfast & lunch).

Host accommodation generally involves a short commute (allow 20/30 mins).

On site residence:

Each room has its own small en suite bath or shower room with wc. No meals are included in the cost – students can pay as they go for meals either on site, in the many varied restaurants/cafes along the sea front or go into town. In addition the residence offers higher standard rooms for one person or couples to share, with en suite bathrooms, TV, fridge and small private balcony. There are also some larger Studios on site (they cost more, but are very comfortable and are in high demand).







Background information

The school was established in 1971 and is located in a purpose built residence only 10 minutes' walk downhill, to the main beach front area, with an amazing array of bars and restaurants to suit all pockets and appetites. It is also only 20 minutes by bus to the centre of Malaga city. Students love the local area, located up in the hills, amongst pleasant, low level villas with good local amenities and an easy stroll down to the beach.

The college facilities include 20 classrooms, most with a TV & video, a small cinema, private study area and a multimedia centre with computer learning facilities. In addition, the college has beautiful sun terraces, a restaurant and bar, a dance studio, a small pool and laundrette. The college residence is on site, which ensures that the social focal point for students is the sun terraces in all but the poorest of weathers! The college teachers are all native speakers of Spanish, with University degrees or comparable experience, who specialise in teaching Spanish as a second language.
