Lindau, with 26,000 inhabitants, is a picturesque, medieval town on an island in Lake Constance, Germany's biggest lake. The area is one of Germany's most magnificent regions of unsurpassed beauty. A lovely landscape with small lakes, vineyards, small forests and the panorama of the Austrian & Swiss Alps. The old part of the town on its own island, with its harbour, churches, towers & narrow lanes is truly idyllic.
