Established in 1992, the French language school moved to a 19th century town house in late 2023. There are 5 classrooms, a magnificent lounge reserved for students to relax between classes and a delightful interior courtyard. The school is situated in the lively Chartrons district, a former wine trading center. It is easy to access, close to many bars, restaurants and shops and has excellent transport connections. At the heart of Bordeaux gastronomy, the school is located between the Musée du Vin et du Négoce and the Cité du Vin. With over 30 years of teaching experience the college offers a highly enjoyable central city environment to suit ALL linguistic needs from beginner through to the advanced learner (across 6 language levels on general language courses) and caters for between 80 and 200 students each month.

The city appeals as a year-round destination, as there is so much to do and see, whatever the season.

Situated in the southwest of France, Bordeaux lies close to the Atlantic seaboard and is the capital of the Aquitaine region. It is set on the banks of the river Garonne and is famous for its magnificent wines. Home to some 700,000 people, Bordeaux is a thriving University city with style ~ wide avenues, neo-classical architecture and elegant public parks. Standard (20) Course

The Standard course is made up of twelve face to face lessons per week, four lessons focused on a specific project overseen by your teacher (a survey or interviews etc encouraging active use of the French language), two mentoring lessons of targeted exercises etc to address linguistic enabling weaknesses personalised teacher attention, plus two "Meeting the locals" sessions, where a local French speaker will give a talk on their career or a trip to a local business (overseen by a teacher, to ensure students improve their ear for the French language). Start dates throughout the year.

Class size: max 14 people. Ideal for all age groups (17 yrs+) and language abilities.

Intensive (30) Course

As Standard programme plus a further 6 small group & 2 private lessons each week and 2 tutoring sessions. Maximum 4 weeks.

French & Wine courses


