Established in 2014, the French language school is located to the east of the city centre. This modern school caters for around 430 students each year, offering a small school environment with 15 classrooms (with air con), a resource library of books, manuals, games, audio-visual equipment, magazines and offers 20 computers for student use, plus a communal student area. The school is situated to the east of the city centre, just a 10 minute tram ride from the historic city centre. It is easy to access, close to many bars, restaurants and shops and has excellent transport connections.

With over 15 years of teaching experience the college offers a highly enjoyable central city environment to suit ALL linguistic needs from beginner through to the advanced learner (across 5 language levels on general language courses) and caters for between 30 and 60 students each month.

The city appeals as a year-round destination, as there is so much to do and see, whatever the season. Situated in the southwest of France, Bordeaux lies close to the Atlantic seaboard and is the capital of the Aquitaine region. It is set on the banks of the river Garonne and is famous for its magnificent wines. Home to some 700,000 people, Bordeaux is a thriving University city with style ~ wide avenues, neo-classical architecture and elegant public parks. There is a lively student scene throughout the academic year, though of course it is the wine industry and commerce generally, that brought great wealth to the region.

Standard (20) Course

Class size: max 14 people.
Ideal for all age groups (16 yrs+) and language abilities.

Start dates throughout the year
The group course is designed for adult learners (of all abilities) who want to be able to speak and understand French and utilise their language skills in everyday situations, whilst expressing themselves confidently in French.

The Standard Course for adults is offered to everyone from 16yrs+, from beginner to advanced level. Classes focus on all four key skills: reading, writing, listening and speaking, plus the programme covers phonetics and grammar appropriate to the group language level. The teaching staff focus on the practical application of the language to enable students to actively use everyday communication skills, whilst immersing themselves in French culture.

As Standard programme plus an additional 6 small group lessons each week

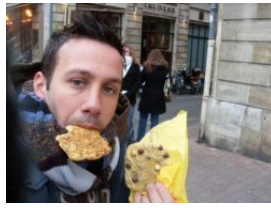
