Located in the east of Argentina, beside the Rio de la Plata and surrounded by the Pampas (flat lands), Buenos Aires is a 24/7 city, with wide boulevards, leafy parks, amazing buildings and a great nightlife. There are countless art galleries, theatres, museums & restaurants, but it is Eva Perón, tango and football, for which the city is famed.

The porteños (people of the port) are a mixture of the Spanish founders & 19th c. Italian immigrants ~ must sees include the 220ft Obelisco, Plaza de Mayo, the Casa Rosada (Presidential Palace), coffee in Café Tortoni & La Recoleta Cemetery (Evita's final resting place) ~ La Boca (a barrio famous for the Boca Juniors, for whom Diego Maradona played & its multi-coloured wooden and corrugated-iron houses) ~ Teatro Colón (if you love Opera) ~ A year round mild climate, though it gets hot and humid during the summer (December to February).
