

## Summer Teenage Course Tarragona 2020



### Course Timetable

#### Monday to Friday:

- ~ Breakfast with family
- ~ Language classes
- ~ PM: Activities
- ~ Dinner with the family or in residence
- ~ Free time: In accordance with curfew rules

#### Weekend:

- ~ Saturday: Full day excursion with group leaders
- ~ Sunday: Free day (or time spent with hosts)

There are up to 100 students present each week, divided into different language level classes. Tutors are all native speakers who are also professional teachers of Spanish as a foreign language.

A placement test will be taken on arrival, to establish your level.

### Age groups: 13 / 17 yrs

#### Is this the course for you?

Yes. If you're looking for fun & total immersion in Spanish. This dedicated teenager course attracts students of many nationalities. The teenagers course takes place in Tarragona, a pleasant coastal resort approximately 100 km south of Barcelona (86 km from the airport).

Group lessons in AM: **15**

#### Language skills covered:

Classes are held Monday to Friday. Only Spanish is spoken in the classroom and the teachers are demanding. The students study and practice Spanish across four key areas:

1/Grammar, 2/Composition, 3/Vocabulary & 4/Conversation – in total for three hours of structured study per day. Students successfully meeting course objectives will receive a diploma at the end of the course.



## Language School:

Founded in 1980, the IH Tarragona language school is on the Rambla Nova, right in the centre of Tarragona, a UNESCO World Heritage city of 100,000 inhabitants on the Costa Dorada, south of Barcelona. It is fully air-conditioned, has 7 classrooms, a computer room, WiFi access, common rooms and is only 2 minutes walk from Plaza Mayor.



### Curfew:

Monday to Thursday & Sunday:

Return to host/residence by **11.00pm**

Friday & Saturday:

Return to host/residence by **12.00pm**

This policy is strictly enforced by both the monitor at the residence and the host families (and the latter may set earlier curfews).

No alternative later curfew can be offered. Failure to comply will be notified to the parents.

**Students are given a 24/7 contact number for staff.**

## Accommodation

### With Spanish hosts

Two to four students live with each hostess, staying in shared rooms. Families are carefully selected and each one has been visited. Two students share a room. Some families have children of their own, others do not. Most hosts live just 10/20 minutes walk from the school, and students take part in family life.

*All host families agree to fulfil the following conditions:*

To provide students with rooms which are comfortably furnished/ To provide basic laundry facilities and to change bed linen and towels weekly / To make a daily bath or shower available / To provide students with all meals (which may include a packed lunch on some days) / To provide students with a door key so that they can let themselves in and out / To treat students as family guests and generally behave in a friendly and hospitable manner / To ensure that students are at home at times agreed by the school or by the student's parents.

Fees quoted include: group tuition, accommodation with full board, shared room, 2-way transfer as per timings quoted, full leisure programme, activities (sports, excursions, cultural visits) & one full day excursion each week.

### In the Student Residence

The Sant Jordi student residence is in the city centre, (houses up to 25 students) and is less than 15 minutes walk from the language school. The residence, which provides accommodation throughout the academic year to students from the University of Tarragona, was opened in 1998 and is very well maintained.

Accommodation is available in spacious double or triple rooms with sheets and towels provided. The bedrooms are equipped with wardrobes, writing desks and chairs, desk lamps, bookcases and mirrors. Accommodation includes all meals.

Facilities that are available free to students include a TV lounge, a computer room, separate study rooms, and a gymnasium. Washing machines are also available for a small charge. Students are provided with a key to their room only. There is a 24-hour reception service.





## Social Programme

The course includes a very full program of excursions and other activities with all costs covered by the course fee. A provisional program of activities for this July-August is as shown below. In the evenings, additional activities will be organised to keep the students entertained. These will include talent competitions, karaoke, arts and craft activities, etc. The precise details of the social program are subject to change, but modifications will be kept to a minimum.

## Travel/Transfers

Airport transfers from/to Barcelona airport are included in the programme, but please note the following time requirements:

Transfer time to Tarragona: 1 hr  
*(depending on traffic conditions)*

### Arrival Flights: Sunday

Flights should arrive on the Sunday before the course between 08.00am & 09.00pm to allow time for the transfer to Tarragona. Taxis will take 3 to 4 students at a time and students rarely wait more than one hour for the taxi to depart.

### Departure Flights: Saturday

A taxi transfer will be organised for the transfer back to Barcelona for 3 or 4 students at a time.

## The course fee includes:

Airport transfer service on arrival and departure (Barcelona)  
 3 hours of Spanish classes per day in multinational groups of up to 12 students  
 All teaching materials, tests and certificates  
 Accommodation as requested  
 Full board (with packed lunches some weekdays and excursions)  
 Full social program of sports and other activities including local visits and excursions  
 Local bus pass *(if living 20 mins+ from school)*  
 Basic medical insurance  
 We recommend students bring €60-€100 per week for pocket money, etc.
