### Courses Available

#### Standard Course

20 lessons per week  
Class size: max 12 people.

Ideal for all age groups (16yrs+) and language abilities. Short term programmes are perfect for those already studying Italian at school college/university or privately, or who wish to get a feel for studying a language abroad, without making a long-term commitment.

Standard course: classes are held every day from Monday to Friday, 4 lessons a day in the morning, with two different teachers.

The course lasts 4 weeks - 80 hours - and is designed to cater for beginner, intermediate, upper intermediate and advanced students.

According to their level, participants can acquire a basic knowledge of Italian or increase and perfect the knowledge they already have.

Beginners can only enrol starting from week 1 of each course. It is also possible to enrol only for 1, 2 or 3 weeks.

All teaching material and cultural activities in Trieste are included.

Classes are held in a historic building in the heart of Trieste, in the Convent of Santa Maria Maggiore, a few steps away from Piazza dell'Unità and from the sea. All the spacious, well-lit and ventilated classrooms look onto the city and the gulf.

To ensure the quality of teaching, staff members have all attended special education seminars and teacher training programs for Italian as a foreign language. The teachers are always ready to help students and will encourage them to get the most from their programme.

In Trieste, the school can book for you a single room with use of bathroom and kitchen by local residents. Living with local people (typically a single person or young couples, often teachers or students) represents an excellent opportunity to practice the language you learn at school.
