Programme details

Only French will be spoken in class

Language students follow a one-week intensive immersion course in this amazing city. The course is appropriate for teenagers who are independent and mature enough not to require constant direction from group leaders.

All teachers are fully qualified and experienced in teaching French as a foreign Language.

The course is academically demanding, and the French language school staff are aware that the students want to make the most of their time in Paris and will do all they can to assist students to ensure they enjoy their French experience, both in and outside the classroom.

The main objective is to improve linguistic abilities, whilst concentrating on the skills essential to the A' level (or European equivalent) exam.

Course objectives and methodology

- to prepare for the A-LEVEL French examination

- to train for specific examinations (listening activities, presenting a theme, writing a letter, narrative \sim or summary, etc.)

- to practice general French linguistic skills (written expression, "essay planning", oral / written comprehension, oral / interactive communication)

- to revise French language grammar and build vocabulary communicative methods, role play and use of real documents

French hosts live in the residential areas in Paris - in apartment buildings. You need to allow for a daily commute to college of 25/50 minutes by bus or metro. Hosts offer you the chance to share daily French life with native speakers. They may well have more than one student staying with them.

French A-level Revision Course Notes

College Description

The school is centrally located in the heart of the city. It occupies a 1970s built, central town building, over two floors and is only a few minutes' walk from the Champs de Mars and within easy reach of the Eiffel Tower. This French school offers a wide range of French group courses to meet the needs of students aged 16 years plus, whatever your current French language ability.

The French school comprises of 14 classrooms, catering for both group and private lessons, all with air-conditioning and audio-visual equipment.

Activities

Supervision

Students are not supervised by school staff, out of school.

Curfew

Teenagers aged 16/17yrs old will need signed parental permission to be able to go out in the evenings. French language students, over 18 years of age are not subject to parental permission rules.

Private study:

Students will be asked to complete some homework tasks each night in preparation for the following day's classes. It is important that students complete these tasks in order to take full advantage of the week's programme.
