Students can polish up general Spanish language skills including revision of grammar structures and pronunciation and address any linguistic weaknesses. Tutors are all native speakers who are also professional teachers of Spanish as a foreign language.

* Friday 7th Apr = Public holiday (no lessons will be held, or made up) The combination of its academic record, central city location and ease of access to Madrid's International airport makes it the perfect location for Spanish language students.

This Spanish course allows A-level Spanish language students to address their linguistic weaknesses, giving them the confidence to communicate effectively in Spanish and to develop their Spanish language knowledge.

The course aims to significantly increase spoken confidence and written skills.

Group classes are made up of adult student groups, according to your language level and cover general Spanish language skills in small group classes.

Private lessons enable students to address areas of specific concern, grammar weaknesses etc, or to discuss their topics and fine tune their oral work prior to the exam.

A level Revision course structure:

20 group + 5 or 10 private lessons of tuition per week

One lesson: 45 minutes

Max 9 students per group class

Language skills covered: Grammar exercises, oral and written expression, aural and written comprehension, phonetics, vocabulary

and syntax.

Private lessons: Afternoons Held over 2 to 5 days in the week

Spanish A' level Revision Course Notes

College Description:

Private study:

Students will be asked to complete some homework tasks each night in preparation for the following day's classes. It is important that students complete these tasks in order to take full advantage of the week's programme.
