Teenagers are divided into two different programmes depending on their ages, so that staff can focus on their interests and needs.





Summer camp

Perfect for younger students (13-16 y.o), the Summer Camp is a carefully supervised programme, which still gives the students some free time after lessons and activities to spend with their new international friends.



Summer getaway **16-19**

A programme aimed at students aged between 16 and 19 y.o. who want to take part in a wellstructured supervised programme, but who also have free time to go out and discover the city with other students of their age.

The beautiful school is located in the heart of Valencia's old town, in a Gothic palace, surrounded by history and culture.


The school owners have carefully renovated this historical building to their vision of a 21st century language school that compliments history with modernism.

The school is placed just where the 11th century Arab city walls were standing and still a big part of them have remained inside the building crossing through the school and getting inside the classrooms, creating an atmosphere of history and mystery.

The 2100-square-metre building has 28 classrooms with interactive whiteboards, comfortable areas for students, a sunny patio with orange trees and a rooftop garden to enjoy the beautiful Valencian weather all year round.

The Teenage summer programmes take place in an exclusive wing of the school to ensure all of the teens are together and interacting during breaks from class in a young and international atmosphere.

The school is conveniently located in the city centre with easy access to the accommodation and activities.

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School location

A tangled web of narrow streets, alleys and plazas packed with terraces, El Carmen has become Valencia's most famous and fascinating neighborhood.


The school is surrounded by history, culture, shops, cafes, historical sites and the energetic Spanish city life.






International and friendly atmosphere

Students come from a growing number of countries, all with the aim of learning or improving their knowledge of Spanish language and experiencing the Spanish way of life.

The school's friendly atmosphere is perfect to use your new language skills to make friends.



Spanish courses



There are four Spanish lessons every day, they can be in the morning or following a zig zag schedule (some days in the morning with activities taking place in the afternoon and some days activities taking place in the morning and lessons in the afternoon).

During the course students become immersed in Spanish language and culture, learn how people use the language in real life, how they speak to each other in the street and how they socialise. Students develop skills that they can immediately practice outside the classroom.

Spanish lessons focus on communication skills, although grammar and vocabulary are also important.

* Students from both programmes might share some lessons.

Levels

The courses are divided up into 6 different levels: from beginner to advanced based on the Cervantes Institute programme under the directives of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.

No matter what your level of Spanish, they will always find a class that is right for you.

Your Spanish class

All classes are given in Spanish. In general the number of students per class is between 6 and 10 and each lesson lasts for 50 minutes.

Since the groups are small in number, the teacher is able to deal with the specific needs of each student on a more personal basis.

The classes are based on tasks and planned depending on the students' needs and styles of learning.

You will use a textbook in class, together with supplemental material such as newspaper/press articles, adverts, audio-visual materials, etc.

Teachers

The school have a dynamic team of teachers who love teaching Spanish. They're all university graduates and have many years of experience specialising in teaching foreign students.

They use modern materials and methods to ensure that lessons are interesting and entertaining.

Accommodation

Teenagers are offered the choice to be totally integrated into the Valencian life by staying with a host family or share their experience with other international young students by living in a student residence.

Hosts/ess

Our hosts are carefully chosen to provide the utmost comfort and care to the teenagers. Most hosts have been with the school for years, welcoming students all year round.

Students are accommodated in double rooms including full board, and are placed together with another teen of a different mother tongue.

Lunch can be packed or hot. Students can choose whether they would like to go home for lunch or take it as a packed lunch, to school.

Weekly laundry and cleaning are included.

The average journey to school for our students is 25 minutes (walking or by public transport, depending on their location).







Residence

Students can live in one of the two student residences near the school.

There is 24-hour staff in the residences making sure students are comfortable and supervised. Meals are served in the residences' canteens. Weekly cleaning and free self-service laundry machines and driers are available.




Younger students who choose to stay in a residence live in a residence, located in the old town, just 6 minutes walking to school.

Students stay in double, triple, or quadruple rooms with shared bathrooms.



Older teenagers, who choose the residence option, live in a brand-new residence located just 12 minutes walking from the school.

They are accommodated in double rooms with a private bathroom.







Activities and excursions

The programme of activities and excursions will help students discover the Spanish culture, the friendly attitude of the locals and the festive atmosphere of our city.

Every day there will be activities which include cultural visits, sports competitions, barbecues, dancing lessons, afternoons at the beach or shopping. On Saturdays there are full-day excursions, while on Sundays students are free to spend the day with their hosts or to have free time to meet friends and join the school activity in the evening.

Experienced teachers and coordinators take care of the students and accompany them during all the cultural activities, visits and excursions included in the programme.



Arrivals are normally on **Sundays** and departures on **Saturdays** (extra nights might be possible at extra cost).

The school pick up the students at the airport and take them to the host family or residence.

On departure students are picked up at their accommodation and driven to the departure terminal of the airport.

They will be helped with check-in and will be accompanied up to the security control before the boarding area.

Students who have booked the **UM service** with the airline (unaccompanied minor service) will also have to book the service with the school (extra cost) as the airline requires the person in charge to escort the student until boarding the plane.



Supervision and security

Every outing is supervised by school staff who watch out for the wellbeing and safety of the students. Specialist activities such as sailing, paragliding, etc, are always supervised by professional instructors.

Students are expected to attend lessons and activities as scheduled, and have to respect the programme curfew that is established depending on their age.





The first day

On Monday morning host families accompany the teens to school and show them the way back home, either walking or by public transport.

Students living in residence will be accompanied on Monday morning by school staff.

Students will then take a level test so that they can be placed in the class of the corresponding level.

After the test, they will attend a Welcome meeting where they will receive useful information and get to know other new students and the staff of the school.

Once the tests have been reviewed, every student is placed in a group and the classes can begin.

Complete beginners of Spanish don't have to take the level test but will participate in the Welcome meeting.

** It's possible to book the "extra supervision service" if parents want the host family or our staff to accompany the children every day to school and pick them up in the evening after the activities.

All levels can start every Monday from 19th June to 14th August.

Arrivals are normally the Sunday before. Arriving on Saturday

Length of the programme from 1 to 9 weeks

or leaving on Sunday is also possible adding an "extra night" fee. The programme finishes on the 19th August.
