Course Timetable

Monday to Friday:

- ~ Breakfast with family from 08.00
- ~ Language Classes & Activities
- ~ Dinner with the family or in residence
- ~ Free time: In accordance with age group rules

Weekend:

- ~ Saturday: Full day excursion with group leaders
- ~ Sunday: Free day (or time spent with hosts)

There are approx. 25/75 students present each week, divided into different language level classes. Tutors are all native speakers who are also professional teachers of Spanish as a foreign language.

A placement test will be taken on arrival, to establish your level.

Curfew:

13 / 14 yrs of age:

Monday to Thursday & Sunday: Return to host/residence by 11.00pm

Friday & Saturday:

Return to host/residence by 12.30pm

No alternative curfew can be offered. Failure to comply will be notified to the parents.

15 / 17 yrs of age:

Monday to Thursday & Sunday:

Return to host/residence by 12.00pm

Friday & Saturday:

Return to host/residence by 01.30am

No alternative curfew can be offered. Failure to comply will be notified to the parents.

Teachers are based in Plaza Mayor during free time in afternoons and evenings, and students are given a 24/7 contact number for staff.

Is this the course for you?

Yes. If you're looking for fun & total immersion in Spanish.

This dedicated teenager course attracts students of many nationalities and offers a super balance of language study and exploration of Salamanca with additional social activities.

Course Content:

Group lessons in AM: 20 Minutes per lesson: 45

Ages accepted: 13 to 17yrs

Timetable: 09.15/ 12.30hrs or 14.00/ 17.30hrs

Class size: 6 to 12 students Levels offered: All abilities

Number of language levels offered: Beginner/Advanced

Duration: One week+ in residence (July/August)

One week+ with hosts (June/August)

Language skills covered:

Classes are held Monday to Friday and homework is assigned. Only Spanish is spoken in the classroom and the teachers are demanding.

The students' study and practice Spanish across 4 key areas:

1/ Grammar, 2/ Composition,

3/ Vocabulary, & 4/ Conversation

in total for three hours of structured study per day.
 Students successfully meeting course objectives will receive a diploma at the end of the course.

Four levels are offered: Beginners (A1), Elementary (A2), Intermediate (B1 and B2) and Advanced (C1).





Language School:

Founded in 1992, and offering Junior courses since 1994, the school occupies a spacious building on one of the main pedestrianised streets. It is fully air-conditioned, has 15 classrooms, a computer room, WiFi access, common rooms and is only 2 minutes' walk from Plaza Mayor.





Accommodation

With Spanish hosts June to August

Two to four students live with each hostess, staying in shared rooms. Families are carefully selected and each one has been visited. Two students share a room. Some families have children of their own, others do not. The hosts live just 10/20 minutes' walk from the school, and students take part in family life. The three main meals of the day are included. Students receive a packed lunch with sandwiches and fruit on excursion or pool days. The school's Accommodation Officer ensures all meals are healthy and balanced. Students on the Junior Course are not housed together with Young Adult Course students.

In Family Residence / July & August

The residence is just a 10-minute walk away from both the school and the Plaza Mayor, and offers double room accommodation, with your fellow students (total capacity 40 students). The owners of the residence live on-site, and are available 24 hrs a day, throughout July (WiFi connection & access to 2 computers available for students use, at the residence). The residence has corridor bathrooms (one bathroom to every 4 rooms), offers full-board (buffet breakfast, lunch and dinner) and has laundry facilities (one load of washing done per student, per week).

^{*} The evening "Disco" is organized and supervised by school staff.

Students under 18 years old are not allowed to go out to bars or discos in the city on their own.

Activities include: A city tour, museum visits, Salamanca university buildings tour, Cultural classes on Spanish Art & Culture, Spanish movies, Photo contest, Dancing and music classes (Flamenco, Salsa and more), Arts & crafts, Cookery lesson, a party in the school.

Travel/Transfers

Airport transfers from/to Madrid airport are included in the programme, but please note the following time requirements: Arrival Flights: Sunday

Flights should arrive on the Sunday before the course starts before **16.00 hours** to allow time for the transfer to Salamanca. Otherwise an individual transfer will be arranged for late arriving students at a cost of EUR 185.00/ one way.

Individual transfer details: The student is taken by school staff from Madrid airport to Madrid bus station, bought a ticket, placed on a direct coach to Salamanca and then met on arrival in Salamanca by a second member of staff who will then escort them to their accommodation.

Departure Flights: Saturday Flights should not leave Madrid earlier than 12 noon.

If an earlier transfer is required, an individual transfer will be arranged and will cost EUR 185.00.
