The **Music School**, "Il Trillo" founded in 1999, offers a fabulous range of instrumental and singing courses from beginner to professional levels and specialises in classical, jazz and modern music (Rock/Pop/Funk).

The school is divided into departments; classical music, pop/rock/jazz, higher education, young people and infants, music therapy and pre-academic courses in agreement with the Istituto "Franci" in Siena. All the departments offer training across all ability levels.

Levels:

Beginner = up to 2 yrs of study Intermediate = from 2 to 5 yrs study Expert = over 5 yrs of study

Students follow music classes; individual lessons, coaching and ensemble sessions and the programmes are held in a dedicated music school, just a few minutes' walk from the language school.

Private classes are held in the afternoons and are the perfect addition to the Italian language courses. Students generally study from 2 to 4 weeks duration but are welcome to extend their studies for as long as they wish. With 20+ years of teaching experience, the school draws on a staff of professional music maestras.

The courses are designed to follow the growth of the student's musical abilities and to achieve a high-level competence in music, including: sight reading and composition, collaborations with other instruments and singers, improvement of technical and expressive skills, and ear training ability.

Voice Training

This course provides individual instruction in the student's major performance medium. During each hour-long lesson students will gain a basic understanding of technique and development in the voice. Students will pay close attention to breathing, tone development and vocal diction.

The courses are designed for three different levels:

Beginners:

breathing techniques, diction, support and development, and simple vocalization. Repertoire: Arie Antiche, Chamber Music and Art Song.

Intermediate:

a more intensive study of breathing techniques, proper support, diction, vocalization (scales and arpeggios). Repertoire: Bel Canto Art Song & Opera Arias (Bellini, Donizetti, Rossini).

Advanced:

refining technique (support and vocal production), lyric diction (including a German & French, study of stage craft), vocalization (advanced scales and arpeggios) and overall song interpretation. Repertoire: Lieder; Mélodies; Italian, French and German Opera.
