Course Timetable

Monday to Friday:

- ~ Breakfast with family from 07.30
- ~ Classes / Activities
- ~ Dinner with the family / Free time

Weekend:

- ~ Saturday: Full day excursion with group leaders
- ~ Sunday: Free day (or time spent with hosts)

There are up to 80 students present each week, divided into five different language level classes. Tutors are all native speakers who are also professional teachers of German as a foreign language.

A placement test is given on arrival, to assess your level. Classes begin on Monday, after the test.

Language School

Situated on the island, the Lake Constance Campus provides the ideal setting for learning that's fun, fantastic leisure activities and unforgettable holidays with friends from all over the world.

Language instruction and afternoon creative activities take place in the main school site, in modern classrooms. Adult learners will also be present in the building, following separate programmes.

Situated along the shoreline and on a small island in Lake Constance, in Southern Germany, Lindau is a picturesque location, with small streets, mediaeval buildings and fabulous lake and mountain views. It is within easy reach by air from Friedrichshafen, Zurich or Munich and has great appeal to our younger students.

German Class work:

Only German is spoken in the classroom and the teachers focus on making learning fun.

Students study and practice German:

- 1/ Grammar 2/ Composition
- 3/ Vocabulary 4/ Conversation

+ two afternoon workshops focus on conversation skills

Students will benefit most if they have studied German for at least one year (but beginners are welcome on specific dates).

After an initial assessment on the first day, students are grouped in classes at different levels and will work on reading, listening, writing and speaking skills. The teachers will also help them with grammar and vocabulary development, to enhance speech comprehension and expression. The goal is to increase student self-confidence in using German when they return home to continue their academic studies.

Accommodation

With German hosts

Students share a room with one other student. Host families are carefully selected and many have worked with the school for many years. Some families have children of their own, others do not. The three main meals of the day are included. (lunch is taken at the school site). Offered for 1 week+ course duration.

In the Residence

The new 2023 residence is a 22 minute city bus ride from the campus and accommodates 34- people in total in twin rooms, with staff supervision, offered for 2 or 4 week courses.

The school's Accommodation Officer ensures all meals are healthy and balanced. Students are either a short bus ride or walking distance from the language school, some borrow bikes for the duration of their stay (approx 20 mins from the college). Please note hosts are not available on the island itself.

Activities & Excursions:

A range of activities are offered (accompanied/supervised by the monitors) as an inclusive part of this programme including:

- 1/ a fun social programme – various sporting activities, a lake side barbecue, local bike or boat trips and welcome and farewell parties
- 2/ a half day trip each week
- 3/ one full day trip every other weekend to places such as Mainau, the island of flowers, Meersburg, with the oldest castle in Germany or the Alps for summer sledging.
