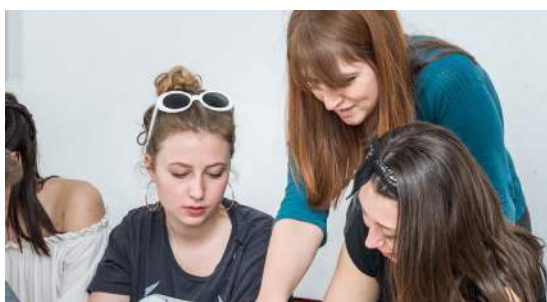


Antibes/Juan les Pins Easter+ Programme 2025

13 to 17 yr olds



Is this the course for you?

Yes. If you're looking for an immersion French course outside of the main summer season, in the beautiful south of France. It's perfect for teenagers of all ages, looking to work on their French, in a well organised teenage only study environment (by the sea) with other language students from across Europe.

The courses are popular ~ so early reservations advised!

Location Plus Points

- Antibes/Juan les Pins offers all the benefits of the Riviera with the charm of the picturesque streets of Antibes, splendid sandy beaches and plenty of sunshine and yet is only 13 km from Nice airport.
- A popular location with teenage language learners
- Combine your French studies with an inclusive activity course

Course Plus Points

- Tutors are all native speakers who are also professional teachers of French as a foreign language.
- French only rule in the classroom
- **No more than TWELVE students** per class
- Perfect for GCSE, A' level or Leaving Cert levels
- Activities and excursions are all overseen by school group leaders

Standard Programme

- **01 to 04 week** programmes
- **20 group lessons** (45 mins x 20) per week
- Up to 12 students per class level
- 09.00-12.20 hrs
- No lessons on the first Monday

In total there are 36 lessons over 2 weeks (unless a day is lost to a public holiday). This is equal to a term of contact lessons at your high school and you are immersed in France, speaking French with native French speaking teachers with classes focused on grammar and pedagogic activities, according to your language level.

Four ability levels are catered for, in compliance with the European framework of Reference:

Beginner
Elementary: A1 & A2
Intermediate: B1-, B1, B1+
Advanced: B2, C1

Intensive Programme

- **01 to 04 week** programmes
- **20 + 06 group lessons** (45 x 26) per week
- Up to 12 students (06 in extra classes)
- 09.00-12.20 hrs + 14.00-16.00 hrs (twice a week)
- **Elementary+** abilities catered for
- No lessons on the first Monday

The extra 6 lessons per week offer extra conversation practise in French language so students can improve their **oral skills**. Small class sessions ensure ample opportunity to talk!

Programme Syllabus:

Monday to Friday

AM : French lessons / PM : Activities and excursions

OBJECTIVES

Acquiring fundamentals of French, basic grammar
Developing practical communicative functions for speaking and writing. Facilitating communication in French through entertaining and/or interesting activities specifically designed for young students

PROGRAMME

Basic grammar programme (20 to 30% of the course)
Didactic activities including writing and speaking practise

METHODOLOGY

Use of various teaching aids:
Specialized material
Documents created by the Head of Studies
Visual documents/ Audio and audio-visual documents
Authentic written documents
Intensive use of the video and of the camcorder
Simulations/ Role plays/ Didactic games
Live practice outside of class (surveys, interviews/reports in town...)

The core group lessons offered cater for beginners to advanced abilities, with the curriculum divided into distinct class groups each week, on a rolling start basis throughout the year. When new students arrive, they are placed in the best class group given their current language ability.



Excursions & Activities

A range of activities are offered as an inclusive part of this programme including

- 1/ half-day trip to Cannes or Nice each week
- 2/ a full day trip to Monaco or Tree Climbing or to Grasse and Fragonard museum (2 wks+ stays)
- 3/ 2 activities per week eg. Trampoline park, Zumba or sailing
- 4/ a weekly barbecue or party night

No activities take place on the first or last day of a course, as the group leaders are busy helping students settle in or depart at the end of their stay.

All students, (host and residence accommodation) attend the evening BBQ event and the end of the week party, with group leaders in attendance. Evening activities are arranged for students staying the residences, throughout their stay.

Host Description

Students can stay with local French hosts/esses, who offer breakfast and the evening meal (lunch is taken at the school) and bedrooms are shared, 2 students per room (max 3 per room). Wifi included.

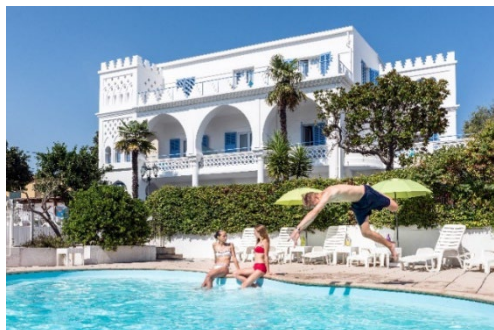
Hosts are most likely to be older single ladies or couples.

Single room accommodation can sometimes be arranged on request. Students walk in each day and should allow around 20 minutes' walk to school each morning.

Residence Descriptions

Whilst we do our best to ensure you are placed in the residence of your choice, we cannot guarantee a specific site. Student placement is based on achieving the best mix of age, nationality, and language ability in the residences, to ensure the best social and working environment, for every student.

Residence One

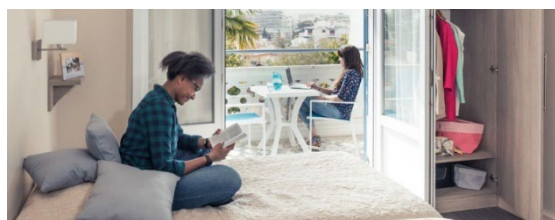


This residence is situated in a quiet area on the border of Antibes and Juan-les-Pins, just 10 minutes walk from the beaches and shops of Juan-les-Pins, and caters for up to 80 students. Students really enjoy the use of the on-site sun terrace, a TV room, a small swimming pool, wifi access, air conditioning and a snack bar.

School staff will live in the residence with the students – so if there are any questions, there is always someone to turn to.

A Moorish building exclusively reserved for the language students

37 double rooms (with small private bathrooms) and a few rooms catering for 3 or 4 students, in a building with 3 levels



- 1,2 km from the main school
- 600 m from the sandy beaches of Juan-les-Pins
- 450 m from Juan-les-Pins centre
- 1 km from Antibes town centre
- 25 km from Nice Côte d'Azur Airport (20 / 30 mins by car)

A small swimming-pool, about 30 m² (with outdoor sun beds) – closed in cooler months

A snack bar with a large terrace, Food and drink vending machines are available on site

A TV room is available for our students Air conditioning in the residence

Travel

Arrive: Sunday

Depart: Saturday AM

Fly to Nice International and take the inclusive college arranged transfer service from Nice airport or Antibes station to the student accommodation in Antibes. The return transfer fee is also an inclusive item in the course fees.

Please ensure the flights arrive on the Sunday at a reasonable hour and depart at a reasonable time on the Saturday. Set arrival days/times apply to the transfer service and cannot be altered.

You are welcome to arrive/depart on Saturday or Sunday of any weekend the school is open, but if not arriving on Sunday, or departing on Saturday a supplement for students is EUR 165.00 (shared room) will be applied per extra night.

Unaccompanied Minor Travel:

Please let CESA know if you book this airline service, so we can advise the school well in advance

Full board:

Breakfast and dinners are taken at Residence One, lunch is taken at the school, at weekends a picnic lunch is offered

Vegetarian meals are offered (please note vegan meals are not offered)

Gluten free meals can be provided – but the supplement for this service is high!

Light cleaning is done every day in the rooms, thorough cleaning once a week. However, occupants are asked to maintain their room in a reasonable state of cleanliness.

Student rooms:

37+ light, airy rooms each with private shower and WC

Each room has two single beds (a few have up to 4 beds)

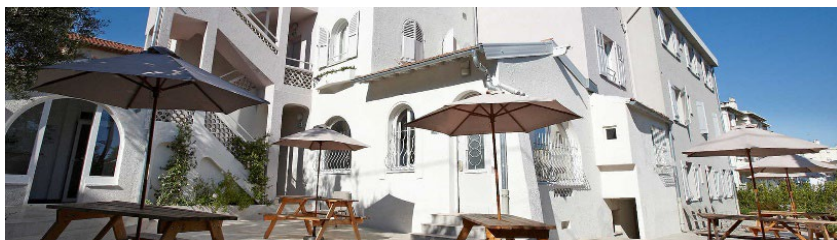
Sheets are provided and changed every week

Rooms are approximately 14 to 20 m²

One bathroom with toilets and shower

Towels are not provided

Second Residence (used when required)



This residence consists of 30+ studio apartments in a very quiet location, a few minutes’ walk from the shops and beaches and 5 minutes’ walk from Residence One

You’ll be able to enjoy the pleasant private outdoor area surrounding the residence.

Free Wi-Fi, coin-operated washing machines, drinks machines, a television room and a reception so everyone has easy access to information. Rooms include: air-conditioning, television, shower room and toilet
Bed linen is supplied and changed weekly. However towels are not supplied.

Full board:

Breakfast and dinners are taken at Residence One, lunch is taken at the school, at weekends a picnic lunch is offered

Vegetarian meals are offered (please note vegan meals are not offered)

Gluten free meals can be provided – but the supplement for this service is high!

Light cleaning is done every day in the rooms, thorough cleaning once a week. However, occupants are asked to maintain their room in a reasonable state of cleanliness.

Student rooms:

30+ rooms each with private shower and WC

Each room has two single beds

Sheets are provided and changed every week

Rooms are approximately 14 to 20 m²

One bathroom with toilets and shower

Towels are not provided

Residence 1 & 2 Access: Room access is restricted for safety and security reasons and to assist cleaning (times are posted on site)



Going Out Permission

Residence accommodation

All ages

All students are welcome to leave campus unsupervised until **19.30 hrs** and must then return for dinner to the residence.

*The school will welcome 12 year olds on the courses, only if staying in a residence, but they will **NOT** be allowed out unaccompanied at the end of the activities. From past experience CESA would only recommend any 12 year old attending if accompanied by an older sibling.*

For 13/15 year olds

Students aged 15yrs or younger will not be able to go out at night unsupervised, except for compulsory BBQ on Monday and Friday party (ending at 23.00hrs). No alternative curfews or restrictions can be implemented.

For 16/17yr olds

Parents must then choose one of the following options:

Option One/ The student **cannot go out unsupervised** after dinner (19.30hrs) apart from the Monday and Friday events.

Option Two/ The student can go out unsupervised **up to 22.00hrs** Monday to Thursday evening and **until 01.00hrs** on both Friday & Saturday, & the day prior to a bank holiday (if applicable) and **19.30hrs** on Sunday evening.

Host accommodation

All ages

All students are welcome to leave campus unsupervised until **19.30 hrs** and must then return for dinner to their hosts.

For 13/15 year olds

Students aged 15yrs or younger will not be able to go out at night unsupervised, except for compulsory BBQ on Monday and Friday party (ending at 23.00hrs). No alternative curfews or restrictions can be implemented.

For 16/17 year olds

Students in a host family will automatically be allowed to go out Monday to Thursday nights, **until 22.00hrs**, including Monday for the school arranged BBQ and **until 01.00am on Friday & Saturday** & the day prior to a bank holiday (if applicable) in accordance with the college director's rules and **19.30hrs** on Sunday evening..

Ready to enrol?

Please enrolment online at www.cesalanguages.com or call the CESA office and we can enrol the students over the phone.

On receipt of your details we will enrol you on the course and send confirmation of your booking, an invoice and a Briefing Pack.

CESA strongly recommends that students enrol as early as possible, as last-minute bookings are rarely possible. A deposit of €300.00 or £250.00 is required at the time of booking (or full fees if enrolling close to the start date).



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
