Intensive Programme

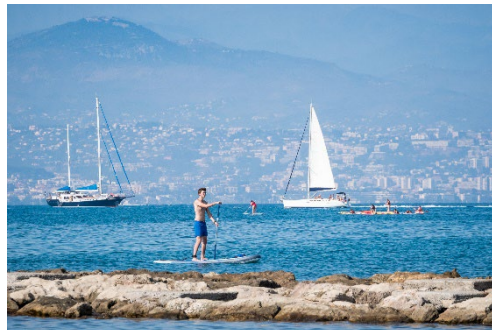
Tues & Thurs or Wed & Fri: 2.00-4.00pm (+6 lessons in total)
6 people max. per class Students are encouraged to talk, learning to express a variety of points of view in French. Role play is guided by your French language teachers.

Speaking French with native French speaking teachers and your fellow students in small classes, ensures learning becomes more natural, as inhibitions are overcome, and confidence gained! In total there are 36 lessons over 2 weeks (unless a day is lost to a public holiday). This is equal to a term of contact lessons at your school in the UK and you are immersed in France, speaking French with native French speaking teachers and the "animateurs" (who organise the social activities each week).

Juan les Pins

Located between Nice and Cannes, Juan les Pins and Antibes are at the heart of the Côte d'Azur. Juan les Pins attracts visitors from across Europe and beyond, scented by pine trees in the park and fringed by golden beaches, merging into Antibes, home to prestigious shops and typical cafes. The area has an allure that draws celebrities and tourists alike, for the beach life, the wonderful weather, the wealth of water sports and the 'Jazz à Juan' festival, each summer.

Students love the turquoise blue seas, the brilliant sunshine, the narrow, cobbled streets of the old town of Antibes, and the modern promenade along the shoreline of Juan les Pins.

Programme Syllabus:

Monday to Friday

AM : French lessons / PM : Activities and excursions

Standard Course:

Lessons focus on oral and written comprehension, written and oral expression, and grammar, pronunciation, and French culture. Students will also be provided with oral activities, with a range of linguistic games aimed to develop self-confidence and aptitude when conversing in French.

The programme offers teenagers the chance to learn French, with native speaking teachers in small classes (maximum 10 per class) focused on the linguistic needs of different language levels; beginner, elementary, intermediate and advanced abilities.

The French teachers have carefully tailored the course to be fun as well as effective, on a programme specifically designed for 13 to 17 yr olds. The methods used are designed to develop each student's self-confidence and enhance their fluency when speaking French, expanding their communication skills.

Intensive Course:

As Standard Course +

6 x 45-minute sessions focused on conversational skills through role playing games and debating. Offered at all language levels.

METHODOLOGY

An exciting range of activities and excursions are offered as an inclusive part of this programme:

No activities take place on the first or last day of a course, as the group leaders are busy helping students settle in or depart at the end of their stay.

Students spend the day at the Water sports centre enjoying a wide range of water sports.

Afternoon trips

Visits to Cannes, Monaco or Nice,
 Action-packed sessions; sailing, kayaking or extreme jet ski-ing, Workshops; bubble foot, fly yoga, Zumba and Laser Quest
 Chill out time on a private beach (waterski-ing, tubing etc.)

Games, shows, a disco, a BBQ evening, themed parties, pizza party on the beach etc.

French Language School

The language school offers:

- 22 bright, modern classrooms
- an on-site cafeteria
- a small private garden
- a large outside terrace

The school is a 15-minute walk from the residence, a bus will transfer students from the residence to the school each week day, and to any activity not within walking distance, (on free afternoons students can walk to the town centre or beaches once classes are over). Lunches are taken at the school, on the large outdoor terrace.

The French school is used for adult language courses as well, but in separate classes.



Travel

Arrive: Sunday
Depart: Saturday AM

Fly to Nice and take the inclusive school arranged transfer service from Nice airport or Antibes station to the residence. The return transfer fee is also included in the course fees. Please ensure the flight arrives on the Sunday at a reasonable hour and likewise departs at a reasonable time on the Saturday. Set arrival days/times apply to the transfer service and cannot be altered.

You are welcome to arrive/depart on Saturday or Sunday of any weekend the school is open, but if not arriving on Sunday, or departing on Saturday a supplement for students is EUR 220.00 (shared room) will be applied per extra night.

Unaccompanied Minor Travel:

Please let CESA know if you book this airline service, so we can advise the school well in advance.



Campus Curfew

All ages

Students are welcome to leave campus unsupervised from **13.30 to 19.30 hrs** and then return for dinner on campus. *The school will welcome 12-year-olds on the courses, only if staying in a residence, but they will NOT be allowed out unaccompanied at the end of the activities. From past experience CESA would only recommend a 12-year-old attending, if accompanied by an older sibling.*

For 13/15 year olds

Students aged 15yrs or younger will not be able to go out at night unsupervised. No alternative curfews or restrictions can be implemented.

For 16/17yr olds

Parents must then choose one of the following options:

Option One/ The student **cannot go out unsupervised** after dinner (19.30hrs).

Option Two/ The student can go out unsupervised **up to 22.00hrs** Monday to Thursday evening and **until 01.00hrs** on both Friday & Saturday, & the day prior to a bank holiday (if applicable) and **19.30hrs** on Sunday evening.

Accommodation



Teenage Residence

This residence is situated in a quiet area on the border of Antibes and Juan-les-Pins, is 600 meters from the beaches and 450 meters from the shops of Juan-les-Pins and caters for up to 80 students. Students really enjoy the use of the on-site sun terrace, a TV room, a small swimming pool, wifi access, air con and a snack bar.

School staff will live in the residence with the students – so if there are any questions, there is always someone to turn to.

A Moorish building exclusively reserved for the language students
37 double rooms (with private bathrooms) and a few rooms catering for 3 or students, in a building with 3 levels

- 1,2 km from the main school
- 600 m from the sandy beaches of Juan-les-Pins
- 450 m from Juan-les-Pins centre
- 1 km from Antibes town centre
- 25 km from Nice Côte d'Azur Airport (20 / 30 mins by car)

- A small swimming-pool is about 30 m² (with outdoor sun beds)
- A snack bar with a large terrace, Food and drink vending machines are available on site
- A TV room is available for our students Air con in the residence

Full board:

Breakfast and dinners are taken at the residence, lunch is taken at the school, at weekends a picnic lunch is offered

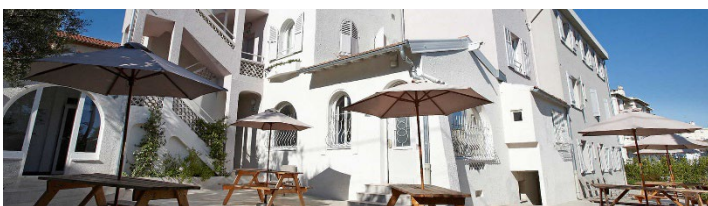
Light cleaning is done every day in the rooms, thorough cleaning once a week.

Second Residence (generally July & early August)



This residence consists of 30+ studio apartments in a very quiet location, a few minutes' walk from the shops and beaches and within easy reach of the other residence.

You'll be able to enjoy the pleasant gardens surrounding the residence. Meals are taken in Residence One.

Free Wi-Fi, coin-operated washing machines, drinks machines, a television room and a reception so everyone has easy access to information. Rooms include: air-conditioning, television, shower room and toilet
Bed linen is supplied and changed weekly. However towels are not supplied.
