




French A' level Revision

Programme details

Only French will be spoken in class

Language students follow a one-week intensive immersion course in this amazing city. The course is appropriate for teenagers who are independent and mature enough not to require constant direction from group leaders.

All teachers are fully qualified and experienced in teaching French as a foreign Language.

The course is academically demanding, and the French language school staff are aware that the students want to make the most of their time in Paris and will do all they can to assist students to ensure they enjoy their French experience, both in and outside the classroom.

The main objective is to improve linguistic abilities, whilst also concentrating on the skills essential to the A' level exam.

Course objectives and methodology

- to **prepare for the A-LEVEL French examination** training for specific exam skills in the Tuesday and Thursday afternoon sessions
- to **practice general French linguistic skills** (written expression, "essay planning", oral / written comprehension, oral / interactive communication) and revising French language grammar and building vocabulary communicative methods, role play and use of real documents in the morning group classes. These classes are open to all students attending the school and class groups are determined by level test.

Open to: 16 yrs+ students

Yes. If you're looking for a demanding French revision course in Paris, living with French hosts (or you can arrange your own accommodation). It's perfect for A' level students looking to prepare prior to their 1st or 2nd year ~ it's aimed at A' level, IB, Abitur, Matura etc students across Europe.

One-week course duration

Additional private tuition sessions focusing on areas of personal concern and topics relevant to A level exam preparation skills.

Hosts offer you the chance to share daily French life with native speakers. They may well have more than one student staying with them.

French A-level Revision Course Notes

College Description

The school is centrally located in the heart of the city. It occupies a 1970s built, central town building, over two floors and is only a few minutes' walk from the Champs de Mars and within easy reach of the Eiffel Tower. This French school offers a range of French courses to meet the needs of students aged 16 years plus, across different language abilities.

The French school comprises of 14 classrooms, catering for both group and private lessons, all with air-conditioning and audio-visual equipment.

Activities

No activities included in this programme.

Supervision

Students are not supervised by school staff, out of school.

Curfew

Teenagers aged 16/17yrs old will need signed parental permission to be able to go out in the evenings. French language students, over 18 years of age are not subject to parental permission rules.

Private study:

Students will be asked to complete some homework tasks each night in preparation for the following day's classes. It is important that students complete these tasks to take full advantage of the week's programme.
