



Spanish for Teenagers Malaga: Summer 2025



Summer Course Timetable

Monday to Friday:

- ~ Breakfast in residence/ family from 08.00 hrs
- ~ Classes from 11.20 or 12.50 hrs
- ~ Lunck
- ~ Activities in the late afternoons

Weekend:

- ~ Saturday: Full day excursion with group leaders
- ~ Sunday: Free day

There are approx. 40/60 students present each week on the summer course, divided into different language level classes. Students improve general Spanish language skills, practise their Spanish daily, revise grammar structures and pronunciation and address linguistic weaknesses. Tutors are all native speakers who are also professional teachers of Spanish as a foreign language.

A placement test will be taken on the first Monday, to establish your language level.

With over 35 years of teaching experience, and between 180/350 students studying each month, the Malaga college offers a fabulous campus study environment for ALL linguistic needs from beginner through to the advanced learner (across 6+ language levels on Teenage language courses).

The school has modern air-conditioned classrooms, a multi media centre, a cinema room, a purpose built dance studio, a restaurant & bar, a fabulous sun terrace and a small swimming pool, plus on site residence.

NB: The college operates as a year-round centre and does not <u>ONLY</u> offer Teenage Programmes for 15/20 years.

Is this the course for you?

You get to enjoy the beach and the sun in Malaga AND learn Spanish AND meet people from all over the world who share your interest! Malaga is a truly "Spanish" city, set on the Mediterranean coast it has something to please everyone. The city is dynamic by day and night, the seaside promenade is alive with restaurants, pizzerias and cafes and the college is close to it all yet set in a quiet residential area perfect for study. It is within easy reach by air from Malaga and greatly appeals to our older teenage students.

Course Content:

Group lessons in AM: 15
Optional private lessons: 04
Minutes per lesson: 50
Spring Group Timetable: Late AM

Summer Group Timetable: Late AM or PM Up to 12 students

Levels offered: All abilities

Spring course duration: 01, 02 weeks
Summer course duration: 02, 04, 06 weeks

In total there are 30 group lessons over 2 weeks (unless a day is lost to a public holiday). This is equal to nearly a term of contact lessons at your school in the UK. The course is a classic combination of language course with a programme of cultural, social and sporting activities and is lots of fun! Tuition is ALWAYS in the afternoons, so there is plenty of time for excursions, sun-bathing, parties, siestas and of course homework!

NB: This course does <u>not</u> have 24hr course monitors in attendance, for further advice please contact the CESA office.



Accommodation:

On Site Residence: 16yrs+

The college has its own year-round campus residence, on the same site as the college itself, which gives students access to ALL its many facilities, but also means there will be adult language students living and studying on site as well. Students can purchase their meals as they go (or book in advance). Breakfast is on site (Monday/Friday), lunches and evening meals may be purchased on site but are frequently taken at one of the numerous cafes/restaurants along the promenade.

Set in self-contained grounds; the College is 15 minutes from the centre of Malaga by bus and only 5/7 minutes on foot from the nearest beaches.

The residence bedrooms are for one, two, three or four students - all equipped with small **en suite shower/WC rooms** (no air conditioning) and **WiFi** access. There are no phones in the rooms, but communal public phones are available on campus. There are a lot of younger students 16 / 22 years of age in the college during the summer and the campus accommodation comes highly recommended by CESA staff and past Spanish students.



Host/ess accommodation: 15yrs+

With local hosts in private households in and around the eastern residential area of Malaga on a half-board basis (lunch being the main meal of the day). The hosts are generally within a short walk from the college, allow 15/25 minutes. Students are housed in single or shared rooms (with another language student).

Travel:

Arrive: Sunday Depart: Saturday AM

Fly to Malaga airport and take the airport transfer service to your accommodation.

Both hosts and residence staff are asked to report any inappropriate behaviour to school staff, who will advise the student's parents. A code of conduct and parental form relating to Under 18 year olds is issued once a student has enrolled.
