



Spanish for Teenagers Malaga: Spring 2025



Course Timetable

Monday to Friday:

- ~ Breakfast in residence/ family from 08.00
- ~ Classes and breaks Morning or Early-Afternoon
- ~ Lunch from 14:00
- ~ Cultural excursions/activities

Weekend:

- ~ Saturdays (& Good Friday): Full day excursion
- ~ Sunday: Free day

Depart Saturday (2 wk students) or Sunday (1 wk students)

There are approx. 15/20 students present each week on the Spring course, divided into different language level classes. Students improve general Spanish language skills, practise their Spanish daily, revise grammar structures and pronunciation and address linguistic weaknesses. Tutors are all native speakers who are also professional teachers of Spanish as a foreign language.

A placement test will be arranged prior to arrival to establish your language level.

With over 35 years of teaching experience, and between 70/350 students studying on all programmes offered each month, the Malaga college offers a fabulous campus study environment for ALL linguistic needs from beginner through to the advanced learner (across 6+ language levels on Teenage language courses).

The school has modern air-conditioned classrooms, a multi media centre, a cinema room, a restaurant & bar, a sun terrace and a small swimming pool, plus on site residence.

NB: The college operates as a year-round centre and does not <u>ONLY</u> offer Teenage Programmes for 15/18 years.

Open to: 15 to 18 yr old students

Is this the course for you?

Yes, if you are a teenager who wants to improve their Spanish!

You get to enjoy the beach and the sun in Malaga AND learn Spanish AND meet people from all over the world who share your interest! Malaga is a truly "Spanish" city, set on the Mediterranean coast it has something to please everyone. The city is dynamic by day and night, the seaside promenade is alive with restaurants, pizzerias and cafes and the college is close to it all yet set in a quiet residential area perfect for study. It is within easy reach by air from Malaga and greatly appeals to our older teenage students.

Course Content:

Spring Group Timetable: Morning or Early-Afternoon

Class size: Up to 12 students Levels offered: All abilities

Spring course duration: 01 or 02 weeks

In total there are 30 group lessons over 2 weeks (unless a day is lost to a public holiday). This is equal to nearly a term of contact lessons at your school in the UK. The course is a classic combination of language course with a programme of cultural activities.

Tuition is held in the morning or late morning/early afternoon (but may also be an afternoon timetable, depending on student numbers), so there is plenty of time for excursions, sun-bathing, siestas and of course homework!

NB: This course does <u>not</u> have 24hr course monitors in attendance, for further advice please contact the CESA office.



Accommodation:

On Site Residence: 16yrs+

The college has its own year-round campus residence, on the same site as the college itself, which gives students access to ALL its many facilities, but also means there will be adult language students living and studying on site as well. Students must purchase their meals as they go, breakfast on site (Monday/Friday), lunches and evening meals may be purchased on site but are frequently taken at one of the numerous cafes/restaurants along the promenade.

Set in self-contained grounds; the College is 15 minutes from the centre of Malaga by bus and only 5/7 minutes on foot from the nearest beaches.

The residence bedrooms are for one, two or three students - all equipped with small **en suite shower/WC rooms** (no air conditioning) and **WiFi** access. There are no phones in the rooms, but communal public phones are available on campus. The campus accommodation comes highly recommended by CESA staff and past Spanish students.



Host/ess accommodation: 15yrs+

With local hosts in private households in and around the eastern residential area of Malaga on a half-board basis (lunch being the main meal of the day). The hosts are generally within a short walk from the college, allow 15/25 minutes. Students are housed in single or shared rooms (with another language student).

Going Out Permission:

Participants on this Programme are <u>not</u> given a curfew, however the hosts and residence staff are asked to report any inappropriate behaviour to the college, who will forward it on to the student's parents. Please note this college also offers adult programmes throughout the summer. A code of conduct relating to Under 18 year olds is detailed in the Briefing Pack, issued once a student is enrolled.
