Course Timetable

Monday to Friday:

- ~ Breakfast with family from 08:00 to 09:00
- ~ Classes and breaks from 09:30 to 14.00
- $^{\sim}$ Lunch with monitor from 14:00 to 15:00
- ~ Activities from 15:00 to 19:00 (Monday, Wednesday, Friday)
- $^{\sim}$ Homework and revision 19.30 to 20.30
- ~ Dinner with the family starting at 20:30
- ~ Surfing option: Tuesday & Thursday PM For a supplementary fee

Weekend:

- $^{\sim}$ Saturday: Full day excursion from 10:00 to 18:00
- ~ Sunday: Free day with the family

There are generally 25/35 students present each week, divided over 3 or 4 language level classes. Students improve general Spanish language skills, practise their Spanish daily, revise grammar structures and pronunciation and address linguistic weaknesses. Tutors are all native speakers who are also professional teachers of Spanish as a foreign language.

Open to: 14 to 17 year old students

Is this the course for you?

Yes if you are a teenager who wants to improve their Spanish!

You get to enjoy the sunshine of summer in San Sebastian AND learn Spanish AND meet people from all over the world who share your interest!

San Sebastian - City, Sea, and Mountains - is the ideal destination to study Spanish especially for teenagers (14-17yrs). San Sebastian offers the best of both worlds: an array of cultural opportunities, in a beautiful city on the coast and yet San Sebastian is small enough to be safe, comfortable, and less overwhelming than its larger European counterparts.

Course Content:

5 group lessons of tuition per day (Monday to Friday)

One lesson: 45 minutes

Max 12 students per group class

3 afternoon activities per week

One full day excursion on Saturday (if staying 2 wks+)

Option to take surfing sessions or cookery classes twice a week

Language skills covered: Grammar exercises, Oral and written expression, Aural and written comprehension, Phonetics, vocabulary and syntax.

Offered during June, July and August the programme takes advantage of everything that San Sebastian has to offer combining sports, excursions, culture, history and events.





Minimum duration: One week Average duration: Two to Three weeks

Teenagers are supervised by a school monitor who coordinates teachers, host families, organisation of activities, and the overall well-being of the students. However, students will have two free afternoons as well as all day Sunday to get to know their host family and become familiar with Spanish traditions and culture.

Accommodation

With Spanish hosts

Each student will be placed with a family with whom they will live during their stay here. Breakfast and dinner will take place with the family (lunch is arranged by the school group leader). This system works well because the student receives the support of a family structure and will be looked after when not participating in school functions.

The families we use for this programme are carefully chosen with the Teenager programme in mind. The student will receive a warm welcome and become another member of the household. Students must respect the programme schedule and inform the family of any outings they have during the designated free time periods.
