Course Timetable

Monday to Friday:

- ~ Breakfast with family from 8:30 to 9:00
- ~ Classes and breaks from 9:30 to 13:00
- ~ Dance class/Sports or Internet time
- ~ Lunch at school from 14.00 to 15.00
- ~ Activities from 15:30 +
- ~ Dinner with the family starting at 20:00

Weekend:

- ~ Saturday: Full day excursion from 08.30 to 20:00
- ~ Sunday: Free day with the family or transfer day

Student Supervision

Teenagers are supervised by school staff, who coordinate; teachers, host families, classes, activities, transfers, and the overall well-being of the students. However, students will have some free time as well as all day Sunday with their host family.

Open to: 13 to 17 yr old students

Is this the course for you?

Yes if you are a teenager who wants to improve their Spanish in the Easter or Summer holidays!

A charming Andalucian town, Benalmadena was originally a fishing village. It is still a sea of white washed houses, with good shops, a wonderful marina and beaches just a short walk away. It is within easy reach of Malaga airport (20/30 minutes transfer). The combination of seaside location, other teens from across Europe and beyond, good tuition and a busy social programme greatly appeals to our students.

Course Content

3 group lessons of tuition per day (Monday to Friday)

One lesson: 60 minutes

Max **15 students** per group class

3 PMs/Easter & 4 PMs/Summer of sport and cultural activities per week (*football, basketball, swimming etc*)

One afternoon of dance class per week (*summer only*)

Sevillanas, Salsa and other Latino dances

One half day excursion (in the week)

Malaga, Marbella, Mijas & Nerja

One full day excursion on Saturday

Granada, Seville, Cordoba or Ronda, includes entrance fees to any museums or monuments

Evening activities per week

Easter – one or two evenings. Summer – three evenings per week; fancy dress party, a trip to the cinema, bowling etc.

Language skills covered:

Grammar exercises, Oral and written expression, Aural and written comprehension, Phonetics, vocabulary and syntax. Morning studies revolve around formal classroom study based on modern teaching methods combined with project work and various social activities to introduce the students to Spanish culture and lifestyle.

Lessons are held in the year-round language school or (in the busiest summer months) in a modern state school, just a short walk downhill to the beach and the shopping centre of Benalmadena. There are generally 45/120 students present each week, divided over 4 to 6 language level classes. Students improve general Spanish language skills, practise their Spanish daily, revise grammar structures and pronunciation and address linguistic weaknesses. Tutors are all native speakers who are also professional teachers of Spanish as a foreign language.

Accommodation

With Spanish hosts

Students are housed in shared rooms with another language student, with hosts or a hostess, during their stay. Breakfast and dinner will take place with the hosts/ess (lunch is arranged at the school during the week, and as a picnic lunch at the weekend). This system works well because the student receives the support of their Spanish hosts/ess and will be looked after when not participating in school functions. The student will receive a warm welcome and become another member of the household.

The hosts/ess are generally within a short walk from the language school, but late enrolments may mean students can be up to 30 minutes commute, including a short train journey, from the college.

Travel/Transfers

Two way transfer from Malaga airport

Free of charge, an inclusive part of the programme

NB: Arriving before 07.00hrs or after 23.00hrs will incur a surcharge: **€25.00** one way

Unaccompanied Minor surcharge:

€35.00 / Arrival or **€50.00** / Arrival & Departure

Young children travelling without a parent or legal guardian are Unaccompanied Minors (UM). Most airlines provide a service to assist these children from their point of departure to their final destination. If you book the UM service with your airline, we will provide, in advance, the name and telephone number of the person who will pick up the student at the airport and the same person will accompany the student until the boarding gate.

Curfew Rules

All students can go out during the day up to 19.30hrs

All language classes, activities and excursion are compulsory

Easter period: All ages

Curfew is set as **23.00hrs Sunday to Thursday** and **24.00hrs on Friday/Saturday night**. An earlier curfew can be set by parents if required.

Summer 16/17 year olds

Curfew is set as **24.00hrs Sunday to Thursday** and **01.00hrs on Friday and Saturday**.

Summer 13/15 year olds

Curfew is set as **24.00hrs Sunday to Thursday** and **24.00hrs on Friday and Saturday**.

Parents will be asked to confirm their agreement to this arrangement (or to confirm that the student cannot go out in the evening and will therefore have to stay in with their hosts). Please ensure your child understands and agrees to abide by the curfew rules. Any infringement of the curfew set will be passed to the student's parents for their information.
