For teens aged 16 to 17 yrs

- o **01 to 04 week** programmes
- 20 group lessons Monday/Friday (20 X 45 mins)
- Up to 15 students per class level
- o 09.00 / 12.20hrs (or PM timetable)
- No lessons on the first Monday

In total there are 36 lessons over 2 weeks (unless a day is lost to a public holiday). This is equal to a term of contact lessons at your school in the UK and you are immersed in France, speaking French with native French speaking teachers and the "animateurs" (who help organise the social activities each week).

Four ability levels are catered for, in compliance with the European framework of Reference:

Beginner Intermediate: B1-, B1, B1+ Elementary: A1 & A2 Advanced: B2, C1

After French classes: a visit to a beach, an excursion to Monaco, Aqua-splash, sailing, pool games, parties on campus and more ... and permission to leave the premises subject to parental approval.

Ages: 16/17 yr olds

Yes. If you're looking for an immersion French course, in the beautiful south of France. It's perfect for older teenagers looking to work on their French, in a well organised teenage only study environment (by the sea) with other language students from across Europe.

Excursions & Activities

A range of inclusive (and compulsory) activities are offered as part of this programme:

Excursions: A day of exploration at the weekend in Monaco or Nice etc. Travel is by coach, boat or sometimes train and accompanied by group leaders. Picnic lunches are provided.

Day time activities: A variety of supervised activities are offered; tree-top park, a "Fun" afternoon either snorkelling, visiting a private beach or sailing with a local Sailing Club.

Evening activities: Movie/McDonalds or beach/pizza and games, shows, a disco night on campus. Group leaders become choreographers and impresarios....

* Aside from the BBQ and end of week party, the evening activities are only for students who have booked residence accommodation

No activities take place on a student's first or last day and Sundays are always free days as group leaders are busy helping students departing at the end of their stay.

Additional activities

Offered throughout the summer at additional cost Examples: banana boat trip/ \leq 20, laser game/ \leq 20, cinema/ \leq 8, aquasplash/ \leq 35, paintball/ \leq 35).

Students are advised of the options once in Cannes.

PROGRAMME

Standard Course: Beginners to advanced ability 20 lessons/ 09.00 / 12.20hrs (or PM timetable)

Intensive Course: Elementary+ ability

25 lessons/ 08.30-12.45hrs (or PM timetable)

Acquiring fundamentals of French, basic grammar Developing practical communicative functions, including one hour a day focused on conversation skills and two hours focused on oral and written comprehension, written and oral expression, plus grammar, pronunciation, and French culture.

METHODOLOGY

The curriculum is divided into distinct classes each week, on a rolling start basis throughout the summer. When new students arrive, they are placed in the most appropriate class based on their current language ability.

We do not recommend these weeks for <u>one week course</u> students (as effectively there will only be three days of language tuition).

First Monday:

No lessons held, students are tested and have an orientation session. Classes begin on Tuesday in the first week.

Arrive: Sunday Depart: Saturday AM

Fly to Nice International and take the inclusive college transfer service from Nice airport or Cannes station to Cannes. The return transfer fee is also included in the course fees.

Please ensure the flights arrive and depart at a reasonable hour.

Set arrival days/times apply to the transfer service and cannot be altered.

You are welcome to arrive/depart on Saturday or Sunday of any weekend the college is open, but if not arriving on Sunday, or departing on Saturday a supplement of € 170.00 per night will be charged.

Accommodation

Residence

16/17 yrs of age



Students are housed in a lovely school campus, a 15-minute walk from the town centre and sandy beaches.

The campus is 1.5 miles from the town centre and beaches.

School shuttle buses provide transportation for supervised excursions or free time subject to parental permission.

It is housed in a high school listed as a historic monument by the heritage department of the French administration.

On-site residence:

The campus offers a fully equipped living quarters that hosts up to 200 students each week in a secure setting.

Classrooms, accommodation, large self-service restaurant, plus there are plenty of quiet spots where students can find a little peace and relax.

You can be placed with a friend on request, otherwise the staff will aim to place you with a student of a different mother tongue, if you travel out on your own.

Outdoor sports pitches.

A swimming pool (above ground, think relaxing rather than serious length work!).

French lessons:

Held on campus, in well-equipped rooms for 2 students, with a private bathroom (shower and wc) shared by two bedrooms.

Please note: No air conditioning at the residence

Full board:

All meals are taken on the campus except on Saturday & Sunday (excursion days, when picnic lunches are arranged).

Vegetarian meals can be offered (vegan meals are not offered)

Gluten free meals: EUR 160.00 per week

Notes:

- We recommend students in the residence bring a pair of single sheets and a pillowcase with them, as the disposable sheets arranged by the school are not popular.
- Students are not able to access the shared rooms during the day, they are locked. Exact times will be posted on a noticeboard at the residence.

Going Out Permission

For 16/17yr olds

Option 1/ Up to 19.30hrs: This is the latest students can go out unsupervised after activities,

unless they have Option 2 Parental Permission to stay out later.

With Parental Permission -

Option 2/ Up to 22.00hrs: The latest students can go out after the evening meal (Monday to Thursday evening).

Up to 01.00hrs: The latest students can go out on Friday & Saturday, and the day prior to a bank holiday

(if applicable).

All students/ Up to 19.30hrs: On Sunday evening (no exceptions).
