Intensive Programme

Tues & Thurs or Wed & Fri: 14.00-16.00hrs +6 lessons in total 6 people max. per class Students are encouraged to talk, learning to express a variety of points of view in French. Role play is guided by your French language teachers.

Speaking French with native French speaking teachers and your fellow students in small classes, ensures learning becomes more natural, as inhibitions are overcome, and confidence gained! In total there are 36 lessons over 2 weeks (unless a day is lost to a public holiday). This is equal to a term of contact lessons at your school in the UK and you are immersed in France, speaking French with native French speaking teachers and the "animateurs" (who organise the social activities each week).

Juan les Pins

Located between Nice and Cannes, Juan les Pins and Antibes are at the heart of the Côte d'Azur. Juan les Pins attracts visitors from across Europe and beyond, scented by pine trees in the park and fringed by golden beaches, merging into Antibes, home to prestigious shops and typical cafes. The area has an allure that draws celebrities and tourists alike, for the beach life, the wonderful weather, the wealth of water sports and the 'Jazz à Juan' festival, each summer.

Students love the turquoise blue seas, the brilliant sunshine, the narrow, cobbled streets of the old town of Antibes, and the modern promenade along the shoreline of Juan les Pins.

Programme Syllabus:

Monday to Friday

AM: French lessons / PM: Activities and excursions

Standard Course: 09.00 to 12.30hrs

Lessons focus on oral and written comprehension, written and oral expression, and grammar, pronunciation, and French culture. Students will also be provided with oral activities, with a range of linguistic games aimed to develop self-confidence and aptitude when conversing in French. The programme offers teenagers the chance to learn French, with native speaking teachers in small classes (maximum 10 per class) focused on the linguistic needs of different language levels; beginner, elementary, intermediate and advanced abilities.

The French teachers have carefully tailored the course to be fun as well as effective, on a programme specifically designed for 13 to 17 yr olds. The methods used are designed to develop each student's self-confidence and enhance their fluency when speaking French, expanding their communication skills.

Intensive Course:

14.00 to 16.00hrs each afternoon

As Standard Course +

Tuesday & Thursday or Wednesday & Friday 06 x 45-minute sessions focused on conversational skills through role playing games and debating. Offered at all language levels.

French Language School

The language school offers:

22 bright, modern classrooms an on-site cafeteria a small private garden a large outside terrace

The school is a 15/20-minutes' walk from the residences, a bus will transfer students from the residences to the school each week day, and to any activity not within walking distance, (on free afternoons students can walk to the town centre or beaches once classes are over).

Lunches are taken at the school, on the large outdoor terrace.

The French school may be used for adult language courses as well, but in separate classes.

Travel

Arrive: Sunday Depart: Saturday AM

Fly to Nice and take the inclusive school arranged transfer service from Nice airport or Antibes station to the residence. The return transfer fee is also included in the course fees. Please ensure the flight arrives on the Sunday at a reasonable hour and likewise departs at a reasonable time on the Saturday. Set arrival days/times apply to the transfer service and cannot be altered.

You are welcome to arrive/depart on Saturday or Sunday of any weekend the school is open, but if not arriving on Sunday, or departing on Saturday a supplement for students is EUR 230.00 (shared room) will be applied per extra night.

Unaccompanied Minor Travel:

Please let CESA know if you book this airline service, so we can advise the school well in advance.





Curfew Rules

All ages

Students are welcome to leave campus unsupervised during their free time, from 13.30 to 19.30 hrs and must return for dinner on campus. The school will welcome 12-year-olds on the courses, only if staying in a residence, but they will NOT be allowed out unaccompanied at the end of the activities. From past experience CESA would only recommend a 12-year-old attending, if accompanied by an older sibling.

For 13/15 year olds

Students aged 15yrs or younger will not be able to go out at night unsupervised after 19.30hrs. No alternative curfews or restrictions can be implemented.

For 16/17yr olds

Option 1/ Up to 19.30hrs: This is the latest students can go out unsupervised after activities,

unless they have Option 2 Parental Permission to stay out later.

With Parental Permission -

Option 2/ Up to 22.00hrs: The latest students can go out after the evening meal (Monday to Thursday evening).

Up to 01.00hrs: The latest students can go out on Friday & Saturday, and the day prior to a bank holiday

(if applicable).

All students/ Up to 19.30hrs: On Sunday evening (no exceptions).

Accommodation

School staff will live in the residences with the students so if there are any questions, there is always someone to turn to.



Teenage Residence One

This residence is situated in a quiet area on the border of Antibes and Juan-les-Pins, 450 meters from the shops of Juan-les-Pins and caters for up to 80 students. Students really enjoy the use of the on-site sun terrace, a TV room, a small swimming pool, wifi access, air con and a snack bar.



37 double rooms (with private bathrooms) and a few rooms catering for 3 or students, in a building with 3 levels 1,2 km from the main school

600 m from the sandy beaches of Juan-les-Pins

You can reserve a room in Residence One (with balcony): EUR 250.00 supplement per week Limited room availability

A small swimming-pool is about 30 m² (with outdoor sun beds)

A snack bar with a large terrace, food and drink vending machines are available on site

Teenage Residence Two



This residence consists of 25+ studio apartments in a very quiet location, close to Residence One and a few minutes' walk from the shops and beaches and within easy reach of the other residence.

You'll be able to enjoy the pleasant garden surrounding the residence. Meals are taken in Residence One.

30+ rooms each with private shower and WC Each room has single beds (2 students per room) Sheets are provided & towels are not provided

Air conditioning Five minutes' walk from Residence One

Teenage Residence Three



This residence consists of 20+ shared rooms around 5 minutes' walk from Residence One, in a Provencal building. Allow around 10 minutes' walk from the shops and beaches. You'll take your meals in Residence One.

Student rooms:

30+ rooms each with private shower and WC Air conditioning

Each room has single beds (3/4 students per room)

Sheets are provided & towels are not provided

Additional Information:

Full board: Breakfast & dinners are taken at Residence One, lunch is taken at the school, at weekends a picnic lunch is offered Vegetarian meals offered (vegan meals are not offered) Gluten free - offered at extra cost: EUR 160.00 per week

Room care: Light cleaning is done every day in the rooms, thorough cleaning once a week. However, occupants are asked to maintain their room in a reasonable state of cleanliness.

How to get to school: A daily free shuttle will take the students to school

Residence selection: The staff will assign students to one of the three residences in order to get the best student mix. A preference for a particular residence cannot be guaranteed.

Restricted room access: For safety & security reasons, students cannot access their room during the day (exact hours are posted on site)

Live with local French hosts/hostesses

Host Description Offered all dates

Students can stay with local French hosts/hostesses who offer breakfast and the evening meal (lunch is taken at the college) and bedrooms are shared (2+ students per room).

Single room accommodation can sometimes be arranged on request.

Students walk or take the bus to the language school each day (maximum 20 minutes trip one way).

Vegetarian meals offered (vegan meals - availability is limited) Gluten free - not offered



Sheets are provided & towels are not provided

Rooms are cleaned once a week

Meals: breakfast and evening meals with your hosts. Lunch at the school during the week, or packed lunches at the weekend or for excursions or free days Wifi

Hosts do not have air conditioning

Students staying with hosts, spend their evenings with family members, except for the BBQ evening on Monday and the Friday party evening.
