

Spanish A level Revision Salamanca 2026



Students can polish up general Spanish language skills including revision of grammar structures and pronunciation and address any linguistic weaknesses. Tutors are all native speakers who are also professional teachers of Spanish as a foreign language.

We ask that each student tells us which topics they need to prepare for their A level oral exam. Where possible these topics are incorporated into the oral sessions during the week (or can be covered in the private classes). Please send in your Topic information (CESA will supply a form) as early as you can and no later than 2 weeks before the course begins.

This Spanish A-level revision course has been put together to help A-level Spanish language students overcome any linguistic weaknesses, giving them the confidence to communicate effectively in Spanish and to develop their Spanish language knowledge.

As with all exam preparation, the key is to practise exactly what will come up on the day. The school has its own revision manual based on exams from specific boards. Sometimes students arrive expressing doubts about talking about their chosen topic in English, let alone Spanish. Students receive practice essays, cribs and conference notes, leaving them free to focus on polishing their oral performance. Their effort really shows. The course aims to significantly increase spoken confidence and written skills.

A level Revision Course Content

20 group lessons of tuition per week

05 private lessons (optional)

One lesson: **45 minutes**

Max 11 students per group (We anticipate a small group of 2 to 6 students each week on this programme – all Sixth formers).

Must be currently studying Spanish at A level (Pre-U, Int Bac, Leaving Cert or Highers) and in Yr 12/13 of school education

Language skills covered: Grammar exercises, Oral and written expression, Aural and written comprehension, Phonetics, vocabulary and syntax.

Timetable: Private tuition: Generally 09.00am *
Group lessons: 10.00 – 13.30hrs

* Private lessons might have a PM timetable if necessary

Please note this is a Spanish language, not a literature programme.

Accommodation

Fly to Madrid airport and travel to Salamanca bus station, where hosts will meet you.
